At the very beginning the Principal of the College and Chairperson IQAC, Dr. Tayek Talom, welcomed all members present in the meeting and talked about the objective of the two-day long interface meeting to review the academic performances of the students in the last university exams and also to discuss the modalities of implementation of feedback collected from different stakeholders in policy formulation towards enhancement of quality deliverables in the college. He invited constructive suggestions from all members for practical implementation.

Dr. M. A. Salam, the Coordinator of IQAC, also extended a warm welcome and requested all members of IQAC and faculty members of every department sitting with the IQAC committee in separate slots, to put forth their pragmatic views for the overall development of academic environment in the college that can be put in place effectively for subsequent improvement in university results.

Decisions taken in the meeting:

- 1. As the performance of students in B.A. III year Pass Course improved significantly from 52.53% last year to 70.8% this year the members expressed their satisfaction over it. The committee was pleased to note the result of B.A. III year (H) students as well that was 78.18% and encouraged the faculty members of Arts stream to maintain the momentum in the succeeding years while trying further for continuous improvement.
- 2. As the performance of B. Com III year Pass students was the lowest at 43.39% the committee wanted the faculty members of Dept. of Commerce to take some curative measures to improve the performances of students to improve pass percentage in the next year. The committee members expressed satisfaction over the performance of B. Com III yr. (H) students that stood at 77.58% and were all praise for two B. Com III (P) students who secured I and IV position in the university.
- 3. Although the pass percentage in B. Sc III year (P) was 66% and that of Honours course was 89.42% it was a proud moment for the members to note that in pass course the college secured 9 out of top 10 positions in the university while in honours course the students of the college secured 7 out of top 10 positions. The faculty members were appreciated very much for their sincere efforts in helping the students bring laurels for the college.
- 4. Regarding the feedback of students for improvement in Computer Facility the house took note of the fact that 5 new desktop computers have been provided in the library for the purpose of browsing of students.
