

This will also help to initiate remedial action to improve the facilities whenever and wherever it is required. The result of the survey will provide a base to plan for the future.

The analysis of the survey conducted shows that, more than 85% students were highly satisfied on the Teaching Learning Process of the institution. Students have expressed satisfaction over the syllabus covered in their classes and laboratories. The survey questions include the parameter like facilities, syllabus, course outcomes and related activities in the college revealed that the students are over all satisfied. At the same time the students highly appreciated and satisfied with the implementation of learning outcome-based curriculum which includes communication of teacher with students, teaching methodology, seminar works and it's follow up made by the faculty throughout the semester. They also satisfied and acknowledged the effort put by the faculty in promoting and conducting workshops, seminars especially field trips, Interdisciplinary Learning Programmes are very much helpful to them to see the world beyond their prescribed curriculum and also motivating them to learn other subject or practical. 

The outcomes of the survey have been outlined below.




1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 416 responses




2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 416 responses




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate? 416 responses




4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 416 responses



5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers. 416 responses




6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 416 responses




7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.




8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.




9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. ⁴¹⁶ responses




10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.




11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you. 416 responses




12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications. ⁴¹⁶ responses




13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of ⁴¹⁶ responses




14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them. ⁴¹⁶ responses




15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process. 416 responses




16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.416 responses



17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities. 416 responses






19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.
